

Situated with a high outlook view, the client's brief at Scenic Drive Residence was for a de-cluttered, family-friendly living area within their 2 level home.

With a winged floor plan capturing Newcastle's sky line to the north, the living, dining, kitchen and playing areas all benefit from the ample natural light and breezes provided by the northerly aspect. The living areas then fortuitously open up to an expansive deck, suitable for entertaining large groups of family and friends.

A few highlight features exist throughout the space. None, however contend with the bespoke spiral staircase connecting the refurbished living areas to the sleeping areas below.

Working with the client in producing the right fit for the space, a series of 3D computer models were developed in order to explore and further test the initial brief for the stair. What was originally thought of as a means of travelling between floors, quickly took the form of something much more exciting. The design evolved from an L-shaped closed riser stair, to a delicately curved form with open timber treads - an exhilarating result for all.

With a young family and regular visitors the client wanted enough space to comfortably accommodate future needs with an impressive feature at the centre of the room, visible as soon as you step into the home.
